	 How is "customers" defined in the above sentence – native retail customers, residential, commercial, industrial, wholesale customers, or ? If the line is used at a higher capacity than 750 MW, will the Minnesota Power customers share be adjusted, and if so, how.
	Response:
 Minnesota Power defines customer as all retail and wholesale customers who take transmission services from Minnesota Power. This also includes all transmission only customers that may take transmission service under the MISO tariff. Preliminary studies indicate that the line capacity will be 750 MW; however additional studies are now underway to update that figure. The financial obligations to Minnesota Power customers will remain constant and will not increase as the result of any change to the capacity of the line.
